

Grants are designed to cover the operating expenses associated with a research study or project. Here are the most common types of grants given by CIHR.



Operating Grants

fund researchers working in **specific priority** areas identified by CIHR.

Training Grants

support and develop the **next generation** of health researchers.



Project Grants

support research projects proposed and conducted by researchers in **any area** of the **health sciences**.

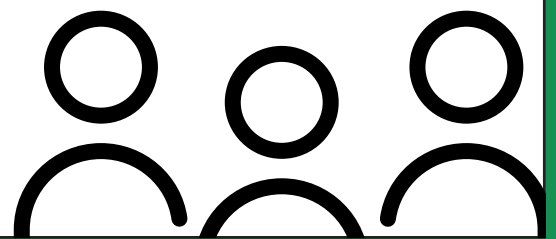


Catalyst Grants

provide **one year of funding**, often for **new, experimental** areas of investigation before researchers apply for larger grants.

Team Grants

support **multidisciplinary research teams**.



Planning and Dissemination Grants

support **planning** or **partnership** development activities that focus on communicating research evidence.



Chairs

support **professors** or **research fellows** recognized for the **excellence** and **impact** of their research.
